- 1 The Dover to Calais ferry crossing distance is **20.7 miles (33.3km or 18 nautical miles)**
- 2 A ham and cheese sandwich dipped in beaten egg and fried is called a **Croque Monsieur**
- 3 The longest Tour De France in history was 5745km long (and took place in 1926)
- 4 The capital city of Morocco is **Rabat**
- 5 The mountain range that runs through Morocco is the Atlas Mountains
- 6 Morocco is the world's largest exporter of **Sardines**
- 7 India shares its' longest land border with **Bangladesh**
- 8 The Tandoori style of cooking is a speciality of the **Punjab Indian state**
- 9 The word "masala" means Mixture of spices
- 10 The southern most city in South America and the world is Ushuaia, in Argentina
- 11 The name of the Central American country that means "saviour" in English is **El Salvador**
- 12 The worlds longest hotdog produced in Paraguay in 2011measured 203m (or 669ft)
